- Research studies by the National Institute of Health (NIH) have determined that over 50 million Americans (about 1 in 6) suffer from chronic, intractable pain.
- Although approximately 20-60 million people suffer from pain, only 9 million seek treatment.
- As the population ages, more people will need pain treatment, yet many physicians don't practice the interdisciplinary approach and don't know where to refer patients.

- The interdisciplinary treatment approach is recognized as the most effective method for pain management according to the American Academy of Pain Management and the American Board of Pain Medicine.
